LAST WEEK OF TERM REMINDERS

This is the last week of the school year. The school day ends at 1.30 pm in Early Years and 2.00 pm in key stages 1 and 2. Pupils must be picked up promptly as club sessions have ended for the term except for the Wednesday swimming group who will have their final make-up class on Wednesday 12th July at the same time. After-school care will be available from Monday 10th to Thursday 13th July; but the school day ends for pupils on Friday 14th July at 12.00 noon. There is no after-school care available that day.
